THIS SELECTION CONTAINS	3 x 9cm Scented Ceanothus thyrsiflorus with powder-blue flowers		
ON ARRIVAL	<div></div> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>Plants will arrive established in 9cm pots, ready to plant.</li><li>Remove all packaging on arrival.</li><li>Try to plant as soon as possible upon arrival.</li></ul>		
WHERE TO PLANT	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>Grow Ceanothus in a sunny, sheltered site in fertile, well-drained soil, protected from cold winds.</li><li>Dig a planting hole 3 x wider than the roots of the shrub you're planting and mix some well-rotted compost or manure with the soil from the hole and use this to re-fill once the shrub is in place.</li><li>We've found that a square hole is better than a round one as the new roots, once they reach the edges tend to grow in a circle round the circumference of the hole whereas when they reach the corners of a square hole, they find it easier to grow through.</li><li>Before planting soak container-grown shrubs thoroughly and allow to drain.</li><li>Remove the plant from its pot and tease out a few of the roots. Add Mycorrhizal fungi to the roots when planting to help plants establish quicker.</li><li>Place your shrub in the hole at the same level at the pot and refill the hole with the earth removed (backfilling).</li><li>Firm in the soil with your heel, avoiding the root ball and water well.</li><li>Mulch around the base of the plant with a collar, compost, gravel, bark etc.</li><li>If you're planting into pots, place some old rocks, stones, or gravel in the bottom of the pot for drainage and ballast.</li><li>Use the best compost you can buy and some sand or grit for drainage.</li></ul>		
WATERING	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>Keep plants well-watered while they establish, especially if planted up in a pot.</li></ul>		
PRUNING / TRIMMING	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>Ceanothus requires no special pruning; only occasional maintenance is needed to remove any growth that has been damaged over winter.</li></ul>		
FEEDING	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>Feed using a high-potash feed such as Blooming Fast Superior Soluble Fertiliser for Flowers &amp; Fruits, to encourage flowering.</li></ul>		
WINTER CARE INSTRUCTIONS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>Hardy to -10°C, protect from cold winds as it is these that tend to cause the most damage to young plants.</li></ul>		
CONTAINER SIZE + RECOMMENDED NUMBER OF PLANTS PER CONTAINER	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>Aim for a pot with a diameter around 30cm to 40cm.</li></ul>
