THIS SELECTION CONTAINS	Nurserymans Choice Perennial 1 Litre Pot x 6	
ON ARRIVAL	• Open packaging immediately on receipt and stand upright where appropriate. • Remove bagging if present on the pots. If plants seem dry, place roots/pots in a tray of water for half an hour. • When growing in containers, don't fill to the brim with compost. Leave up to 2.5cm (1in) of pot on show to allow for watering – halve this for small pots and cell trays. • Pots should always have drainage holes, but place on saucers/trays to prevent surface staining. It also helps retain extra water during summer heat. • Always water prior to planting or potting on. • Prepare soils ahead of planting. For the best establishment, work incredicompost® and incredibloom® fertiliser into the growing area. • Avoid planting when soils are too wet or frozen. • Acclimatise all indoor grown plants to outside conditions. Harden off by placing outside by day and back undercover each evening for 7-10 days	
WHERE TO PLANT	• Pot up plants and grow them on in frost free conditions until all risk of frost has passed. • When plants are well grown, gradually acclimatise them to outdoor conditions over 7 to 10 days before transplanting into borders and containers. • The perennials in this collection can be grown in any moist, fertile soil, in sun or semi shade.
