THIS SELECTION CONTAINS	1 x 2L Not Scented Patio Standard Forsythia Weekend with yellow flowers
ON ARRIVAL	 <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Supplied as an established potted plant in a standard form, between 70 and 90cm tall, with a clump of branches atop a long trunk. Be sure to remove all packaging on receipt of this plant.
WHERE TO PLANT	<p><u>PLANTING IN-GROUND (BED OR BORDER)</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Prepare a hole that is no deeper than the roots on the provided plant but is three times the diameter of the existing root system. Break up the soil on the sides of the hole with a fork before planting. Soak the established root, then place it into the planting hole, with the roots level with the surface soil. Refill the hole – ensure soil is between the roots to avoid any air pockets. Gently firm the soil, do not compress too hard, then water in.
WATERING	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Feed and water freshly planted Forsythia until well-established, then it will become drought tolerant.
PRUNING / TRIMMING	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> The standard tree can be pruned while young. Either shorten or remove damaged, dead, or diseased branches.
FEEDING	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> A fertiliser is not needed when planting, however, can be applied after one season if the soil quality is particularly poor, or to boost growth where it is struggling.
WINTER CARE INSTRUCTIONS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> If planting in winter, be sure to water less frequently.
