On arrival	 <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Open the box fully and carefully lift out the plant, being mindful of the cane. • Remove the polythene bag and dispose of responsibly, keeping it away from children. • Water the plant if the compost seems dry and allow excess water to drain away. • Best planted out immediately, provided the ground isn't frozen or waterlogged. However, the plant will hold for several days in a light, frost-free place and kept moist. • Please recycle all packaging appropriately.
WHERE TO PLANT	<p><u>PLANTING IN-GROUND (BED OR BORDERS)</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Dig the planting hole at least twice the size of the pot. • Sprinkle 1-2 scoops of Root Booster and some compost in the bottom. • Spike the bottom and sides of the hole with a fork to allow roots to penetrate. • Remove the pot and place the plant in the planting hole so that the top of the rootball is just below the soil surface. • Back fill with soil and gently firm in with your hand and then your heel. • Water well with a watering can fitted with a sprinkler. • This climbing plant will perform much better if grown up trellis, an arch or any structure to support the growth. <p><u>PLANTING IN CONTAINERS</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Fill your pot with fresh compost and proceed as above. <p>Top Tip: The more you feed and remove the faded blooms the more flowers you will get.</p>
WATERING	Water plants regularly during the growing season, especially during dry periods.
PRUNING / TRIMMING	Train new growth through the plant support. Cut all stems back as soon as flowers have finished
FEEDING	From April onwards feed weekly with a high potash plant food, such as Flower Power. Continue to feed throughout the summer.

CONTAINER SIZE + RECOMMENDED NUMBER OF PLANTS PER CONTAINER	One plant would look great in a pot that is approx 60cm (24") in diameter and 50cm (20") deep.
