THIS SELECTION CONTAINS	24 x Not Scented Begonia 'Super Cascade' Plug Plants with yellow, orange, red, pink and white flowers	
ON ARRIVAL	 Keep trays indoors in a well-lit, draught free area for 24 hours. If the compost is a little dry, stand the tray in shallow water. Or spray water lightly over the tray and then place in a position where there is adequate airflow to dry the excess water from the leaves. Once the compost is moist allow the tray to drain. There may be some loose compost or a slight yellowing of the leaves which is a consequence of the plants being shipped. This will not affect the condition of the mature plants. 	
WHERE TO PLANT	 Plant straight into containers and grow on for a week or two before planting out. Give your plants a good water initially, then only when the top compost starts to dry. They don't like to be left in standing water. When planting out, space each approximately 20cm apart to allow room to grow. Feed using a high-potash feed to encourage flowering. 	
WATERING	 Check and water containers every day in summer unless the compost is wet. Aim to keep the compost moist but not soggy and avoid wetting the foliage and flowers. 	
PRUNING / TRIMMING	Deadhead when flowers fade to encourage more blooms.	
FEEDING	From March to June, apply a general-purpose liquid fertiliser once a week.	
WINTER CARE INSTRUCTIONS	If you want to keep your begonias for next year, carefully lift them before the first frost.	
 Pot them up and bring them into a cool, frost-free place such as a greenhouse, conservatory, or a bright windowsill. 		ory, or a bright windowsill.
	 Trim back any straggly growth and reduce watering to prevent rot, but don't let the soil dry out completely. 	
 They may continue to produce some foliage indoors or may enter a dormant state depending on temperature and light level 		
	 If you prefer to leave them in the ground, cut back the plants to just above soil level before the first frost. 	
	Apply a thick mulch of dry leaves, straw, or compost to insulate the roots.
