WHEN TO PLANT	Upon receipt (preferably in Autumn/Winter)

THIS SELECTION CONTAINS	1x 12L tree
ON ARRIVAL	 <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Tree will arrive in a cardboard box</li> <li>Remove from box and water well</li> <li>If any damage to the tips, prune off just below the break.</li> <li>Plant as soon as possible</li> <li>If unable to plant immediately keep well-watered.</li> </ul>
WHERE TO PLANT	<u>PLANTING IN-GROUND (BED OR BORDER)</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Dig a hole twice the size of the pot and break up the soil at the bottom of the hole.</li> <li>Remove the tree from the pot and place in the hole so that the top of the soil from the pot is about an inch below the ground level.</li> <li>Back fill with a mix of compost and soil and firm well so there are no air pockets.</li> <li>Water well</li> </ul>
WATERING	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Keep soil moist but not saturated</li> <li>Pay special attention in its first year of planting and in summer months.</li> </ul>
PRUNING / TRIMMING	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Remove all fruit in the first year. Half in the second. A third in 3<sup>rd</sup> year. Thin fruit as needed from 4<sup>th</sup> year of planting onwards.</li> <li>Reduce branches by a third after fruiting.</li> <li>Thin branches where needed to allow light.</li> <li>Remove crossed or intersecting branches.</li> </ul>
FEEDING	Any all-purpose feed once a year or as needed.
WINTER CARE INSTRUCTIONS	Keep base of tree clear from weeds and grass, give a good mulch of bark chippings.
CONTAINER SIZE + RECOMMENDED NUMBER OF PLANTS PER CONTAINER	Not suitable for container planting
