ON ARRIVAL	<ul> <li>You will receive your bulbs packed in perforated polythene bags. There may be some sawdust left in the bags, which is present to keep condensation at bay.</li> <li>If you cannot plant straight away, keep in a cool, dark, moisture-free place and they'll keep for a few weeks with no problems.</li> <li>If your bulbs have been delayed in the post, do not worry, as they will survive in transit for several days.</li> </ul>	
WHERE TO PLANT	PLANTING IN-GROUND (BED OR BORDER)  Plant bulbs at twice the depth of the bulb height, and approximately four times the width. These will be fine to plant even if a little green growth has started to appear. A layer of horticultural grit can be placed in the planting hole to boost drainage.  PLANTING IN CONTAINERS OR BASKETS Arrange a layer of bulbs at the top of the planter, with the pointed ends upwards, on at least 10cm of compost. Bulbs can be spaced closely together, at roughly the same width of a single bulb apart from one-another. Cover the bulbs in a layer of compost, then firm down gently, followed by a thick layer of gravel to deter weeds. Water the pot well to settle the compost.	
WATERING	<ul> <li>Those planted in the ground should not need additional watering, unless there is a prolonged period of hot and dry weather.</li> <li>Bulbs growing in containers can dry quickly, so water regularly through the growing season, right until the foliage dies down.</li> </ul>	
PRUNING / TRIMMING	The foliage should be allowed to die back naturally, rather than being removed while still green. Deadheading is not needed on these blooms.	
FEEDING	<ul> <li>Promote vigorous growth by feeding these garden plants with a general-purpose feed once the flowers have faded, but leaves are still in full growth.</li> </ul>	
WINTER CARE INSTRUCTIONS	<ul> <li>This hardy variety does not require additional winter protection.</li> <li>However, those growing in containers can be moved to a sheltered position to avoid the compost from becoming waterlogged, as this can lead to rot.</li> </ul>	
CONTAINER SIZE + RECOMMENDED NUMBER OF PLANTS PER CONTAINER	Plant in a container that is at least 30cm wide and deep, with drainage holes.
