ON ARRIVAL	 • Open packaging immediately on receipt. • When growing in containers, don't fill to the brim with compost. Leave up to 2.5cm (1in) of pot on show to allow for watering. • Pots should have drainage holes, but place on saucers/trays to prevent surface staining. It also helps retain extra water during summer heat. • Prepare soils ahead of planting. For the best establishment, work incredicompost® and incredibloom® fertiliser into the growing area and give the best results in containers displays too. Alternatively opt for regular liquid feeds through the season, starting at 6 weeks after planting. • Avoid planting when soils are too wet or frozen. Preparation: Bulbs are best grown in well-drained soil in a sunny position. Sandy soils offer the best success, you may need to add organic matter to the soil before planting to improve the nutrient levels. Clay soils may require some grit to improve drainage.
WHERE TO PLANT	Create layers of beautiful spring colour by planting your bulb lasagne into a patio pot with Incredicompost and Incredibloom. Add a few crocks or gravel to the base of your pot to help improve drainage. Before filling the pot, mix the Incredibloom plant food sachet thoroughly into your Incredicompost. Add around 10 cm (4 in) of compost to the bottom of the pot to form the base layer. Start by planting the tulip bulbs ('Secret Perfume') as these are the largest and should be the deepest layer. Place them pointed side up and spaced evenly apart, then cover with about 3-5 cm (2 in) of compost. The next layer is the Daffodil Double Classic Mix, positioned above the tulips with a little space between each bulb. Cover this layer with another 3-5 cm (2 in) of compost. Next, add the Hyacinth 'Gipsy Queen' bulbs, followed by another layer of compost. Above this, plant the Crocus 'Pickwick' bulbs, spacing them evenly and covering them with 3-5 cm (1-2 in) of compost. Finally, plant the smallest bulbs, the Ipheion Mix, near the surface at a depth of around 5 cm (2 in), then top up the pot with compost, leaving about 2 cm (1 in) from the rim. Your bulbs will start flowering in succession from early spring through to late spring, giving you a stunning display of colour and fragrance that lasts for months.
WATERING	Once all the bulbs are planted, water the pot well to help settle the compost around the bulbs. Place the finished pot in a sheltered, sunny spot outdoors. Once bulbs produce shoots, increase watering to boost development.
PRUNING / TRIMMING	Remove spent flower heads to improve vigour and prevent wasted energy on seed production. After flowering allow foliage to die back completely before removing so that the bulbs perform well the following year.
FEEDING	You can also to give a weak liquid feed every 3-4 weeks
WINTER CARE INSTRUCTIONS	Through winter, check occasionally and water lightly if the compost becomes dry, but avoid overwatering.
