THIS SELECTION CONTAINS	2 x Scented Lavender intermedia ‘Sensational’ with purple flowers	
ON ARRIVAL	As Supplied  - Supplied as an established plant in a 2L pot, ready to plant. - Remove all packaging on arrival and prior to planting.	
WHERE TO PLANT	<u>PLANTING IN-GROUND (BED OR BORDER)</u> - Remove weeds, rubble and debris from the free-draining soil you are planting this lavender in and dig over. - If the soil is heavy, plant on a 20-30cm mound, or in a raised bed to avoid the roots from sitting in wet soil. - When planting to form a hedge, space roughly 30cm apart to develop a dense display. - Straight after planting, water well, then again regularly for the first season - particularly in dry conditions. <u>PLANTING IN CONTAINERS OR BASKETS</u> - Choose a container with large drainage holes. - Use a loam-based compost, mixing in coarse grit to boost drainage further. - Plant the lavender so it sits at a similar level to how it was supplied in the nursery pot	
WATERING	- When the lavender is newly planted, water throughout the first summer. - Once established, lavender plants become tolerant of drought, so will rarely need watering, from drought conditions. - Lavender plants growing in containers should be watered regularly across summer.	
PRUNING / TRIMMING	Spent blooms should be cut and removed across summer to encourage potential further flowering.	
FEEDING	Feeding will not be needed in general, as lavender thrives in soil low in nutrients.	
WINTER CARE INSTRUCTIONS	- Move any container lavender to a sheltered spot for winter, protecting against harsh weather conditions. - Otherwise, this is a fully winter hardy variety.	
CONTAINER SIZE + RECOMMENDED NUMBER OF PLANTS PER CONTAINER	Between 30cm and 40cm diameter.	



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
